CENATIC context

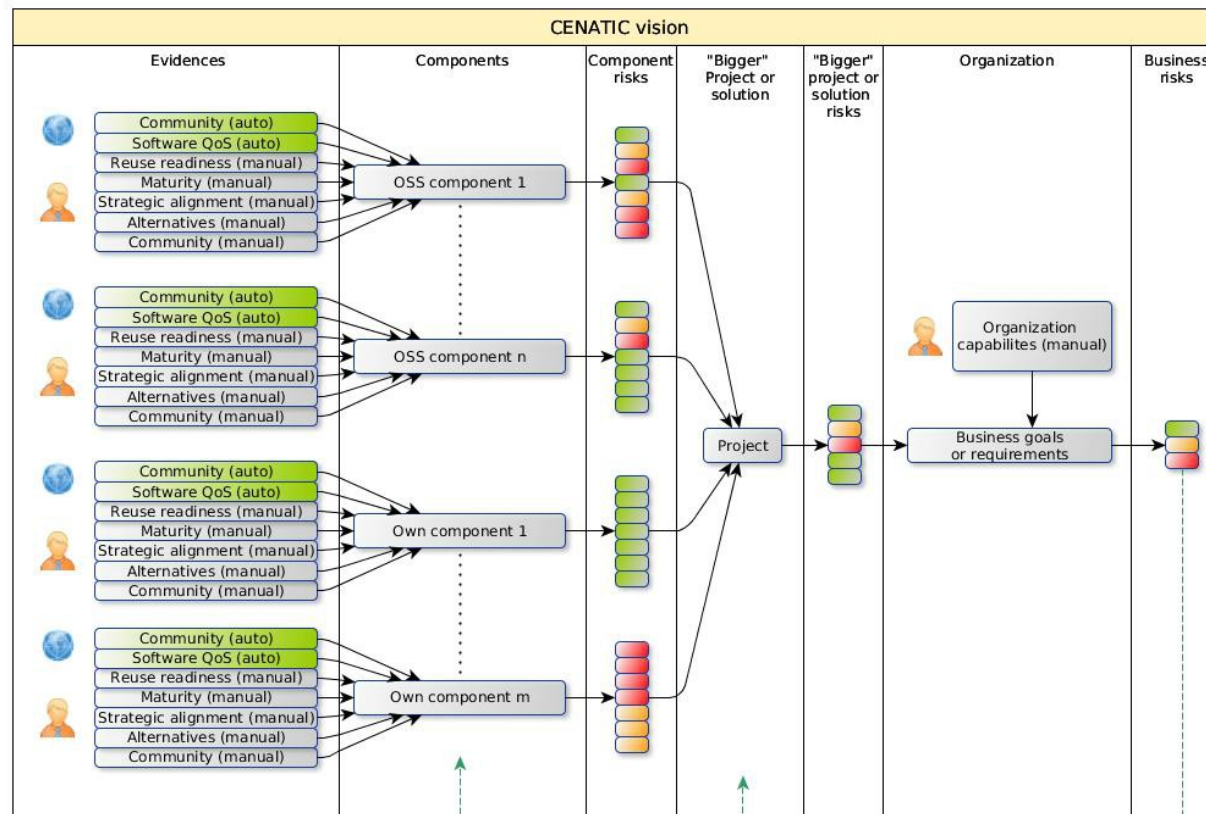
- **CENATIC is:**

 - Mixed software that very often includes OSS, non-OSS, 3PP components, owned components, legacy components... all together!

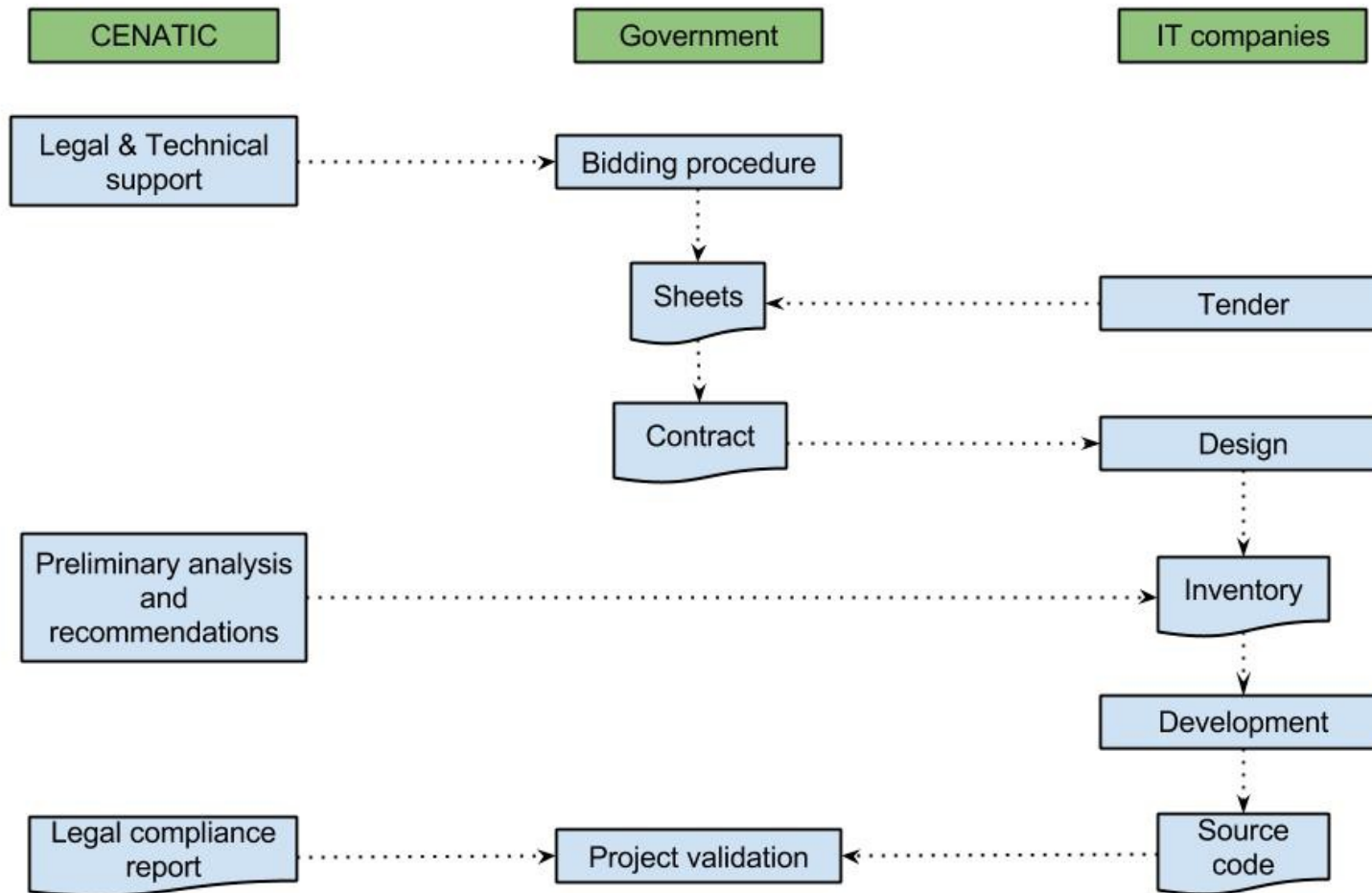
